Role

The Hamilton Youth Pastor provides pastoral, visionary, and organizational leadership for the junior and senior high youth ministries at the three Hamilton parishes with a view to engaging spiritually curious youth in the city. The Youth Pastor focuses on equipping and empowering coordinators and small group leaders as they disciple students to have a life changing relationship with Jesus. Working collaboratively with and through a group of committed leaders, the Youth Pastor gives oversight to the weekly midweek event and junior high Sunday morning programming. This person will lead volunteer teams, develop leaders, and create programming all pointed towards increasing discipleship, volunteer ownership and leadership development.

*In this COVID-19 reality, Sunday mornings and weekly midweeks are not happening in person, but the Youth Pastor is engaging leaders and students online and some in person small group gatherings.

Responsibilities

Model what it means to be a disciple of Jesus



- Pray for the leaders and students in the Hamilton youth ministries
- Cultivate and foster a culture of discipleship with leaders and with students
- Provide organizational leadership for the youth ministry during all midweek, weekend and large event programming for grades 6-12
- Partner with each Lead Pastor (Downtown, Mountain, Ancaster) to identify and develop a youth coordinator
- Provide leadership and mentorship to each of the Hamilton coordinators and youth ministries
- Be present in each location monthly
- Create an open and inviting environment where students' questions and friends are welcome
- Equip and empower small group leaders to authentically live out their own faith by discipling the students in their small group through one on one and regular leaders' gatherings
- Working collaboratively, develop meaningful and creative spaces for the weekly small groups and larger midweek gatherings – in person and virtually
- Oversee all aspects of volunteer support including recruitment, training, coaching, communication, support and maintaining schedules
- Develop and coach a team of volunteers and small group leaders to ensure all regularly attending youth are assigned to and involved in a healthy small group experience
- Ensure all volunteer security clearances are complete and up to date and there is full compliance to all requirements of our Plan to Protect Policy
- Ensure all communication pieces, events and environments reflect the values and ethos of the youth ministry, and ensure the effective implementation of the youth curriculum
- Partner with the Kidmax coordinators to create an intentional bridge and smooth transition for kids from Gr 5 into the youth ministry
- Develop and mentor a Student Leadership Team
- Work collaboratively with the Parish Pastors to support families
- Work collaboratively on Ancaster parish-wide initiatives and activities
- Provide active support for all strategic initiatives of our cross-regional youth ministry including all retreats, large cross-regional events, and shared compassion initiatives
- Participate in cross-regional leadership planning and implementation
